A 3-Lesson Bible Study

God can do anything. God is all-powerful. These are some pretty common things you hear in church. The question is: Do you (and your students) really believe it? In this study, your students will learn to answer this question by learning exactly what it means that God is powerful, and how God uses this power for His glory and our good.

God's Power, one of the studies in the **elements** line of Bible study curriculum, will help students understand that God has ultimate power over all things and occurrences, that Jesus exercises His power for our good, and that God's power is at work in and through us for His glory.

God's Power Lesson Overviews

Lesson 1: He's Got It All

- **Learning Objectives:** That students would understand that God has ultimate power over all things and occurrences, and that they would consider whether or not they truly believe that God has power over everything.
- **Scripture Focus:** Psalm 24:8; Genesis 18:14; Jeremiah 32:27; Isaiah 55:8-9

Lesson 2: He's Over It All

- **Learning Objectives:** That your students would understand that Jesus exercises His power for our good, and that they would flesh out how Christ's power impacts their own personal lives.
- **Scripture Focus:** Mark 4:35-39; Mark 2:1-12; Matthew 22:23-33

Lesson 3: It's In Us

- **Lesson Objectives:** That students would understand that God's power is at work in and through us for His glory, and that they would come to an understanding that they've been equipped to do all that God calls them to do and that their lives can bring God glory.
 - **Scripture Focus:** Ephesians 3:20-21; 2 Corinthians 9:8
