

## elements | God's Sovereignty

### A 3-Lesson Bible Study

The Bible teaches us that God is the sovereign, Creator King. His sovereignty refers to His supreme power to do everything He wills. He is the creator and we are the creation. And yet, in Jesus, God willingly chose to set aside His rights, entering our world to suffer in order to save us. We can trust God because He's in control and He's good.

*God's Sovereignty*, one of the studies in the **elements** line of Bible study curriculum, will help students understand that God is the all-mighty creator king that calls us to follow and obey Him, that Jesus set aside His rights as sovereign king to come and suffer on behalf of sinners, and that true freedom and rest can be found in the truth of God's sovereignty.

### God's Sovereignty Lesson Overviews

#### Lesson 1: Creator King

- **Lesson Objectives:** That your students would understand that God is the all-mighty creator king that calls us to follow and obey Him, and that they would confidently trust and follow God, knowing that His purposes will ultimately prevail.
- **Scripture Focus:** Job 38:4-7; Psalm 115:3; Jeremiah 32:27; Proverbs 20:24; Proverbs 19:21; Psalm 119:68; Psalm 34:8; Psalm 106:1

#### Lesson 2: Servant King

- **Lesson Objectives:** That your students would understand that Jesus set aside His rights as sovereign king to come and suffer on behalf of sinners, and that they would practically define what it looks like for them to follow Christ's example of humility towards others.
- **Scripture Focus:** John 10:18; Mark 10:45; John 19:30; Colossians 1:15-18; Philippians 2:4-11

#### Lesson 3: Peace-Giving King

- **Lesson Objectives:** The point of this lesson is for students to learn that true freedom and rest can be found in the truth of God's sovereignty, and that they would contemplate what hinders them from finding true freedom and rest in Christ, and to think about how to remove those obstacles from their lives.
- **Scripture Focus:** Matthew 6:25-34; Philippians 4:6-9; Romans 8:31-39
