

## Social Media Guide for *The Rescue*: Lesson 15

### Social Media for Students

Use these suggested messages to communicate with your students directly. **You'll notice there is lesson-specific content, as well as some general content.**

- **Send pre-lesson:** Don't miss this week's study. We'll look at the struggle to follow Jesus and how He's changing us.
- **Send post-lesson:** What's one of the characteristics of the new life (Col. 3:12-15) that I can pray that you'll grow in this week?
- **A message to gather feedback:** Did our conversation about being new creations impact your perspective on this week?
- **A reminder about keeping up with the Student Devotions:** We renew our mind through the Word. Don't miss the opportunity to connect to the Word this week.
- **A verse from the study you could send sometime between lessons:**
  - "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" – 2 Cor. 5:17
