A 3-Lesson Bible Study

- **Scripture Focus:** Psalm 86:1-5, 1 John 4:7-8, Psalm 33:4-5, Psalm 143:7-8

Lesson 2: Love's Perfect Expression

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would see that God's unfailing love is most fully expressed through Christ, and how this perfect expression of love positively impacts their identity.
- **Scripture Focus:** Romans 5:6-8, John 3:16-17, Romans 8:35-39

Lesson 3: Loving Outward

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would understand that God's love for them sets in motion their love for others, and how this love is practically lived out in their daily lives.
 - **Scripture Focus:** John 13:33-35, 1 John 3:16-18
