A 3-Lesson Bible Study

Students tend to hear "God's Word" and only think of their Bibles. And this is a good thing. After all, the Bible is indeed God's Word. But a good understanding of God's Word goes deeper than just seeing it as the words on their favorite Bible app.

God's Word, one of the studies in the **elements** line of Bible study curriculum, will help your students see the power of God's Word throughout the Old Testament, how Jesus was the physical embodiment of God's Word (God's living, breathing Word to us), and how their lives can be used to spread God's Word.

Teach **elements** | *God's Word* and challenge your students to be walking examples of God's Word in their worlds.

God's Word Lesson Overviews

Lesson 1: The Word At Work

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that your students would gain a more full understanding of what we mean by God's Word, as well as being challenged to evaluate their own attitude toward the Bible and the role it plays in their lives.
- **Scripture Focus:** Genesis 1:1-3, 12:1-4, Psalm 33:6, Matthew 8:23-27, Mark 1:16-20, 2 Timothy 3:16-17, Isaiah 55:10-11

Lesson 2: The Word In The World

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would see that Jesus' person, ministry, and teachings represent the fullness of God's Word to us, and that they would understand how they are to be communicating God's Word in their day-to-day lives.
- **Scripture Focus:** John 1:1-2, 14, Revelation 19:11-13, Acts 6:1-7, 8:4, 12:24, 2 Corinthians 4:1-2

Lesson 3: The Word And Us

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would understand that as Christ-followers, God's Word must be at the center of their lives, and that they would be challenged to discover (or re-discover) a joy for encountering God in His Word.
- **Scripture Focus:** Matthew 7:24-27, James 1:22-25, Psalm 119:11, 14, 97, 105
