A 3-Lesson Bible Study

SALVATION IS A FAMILIAR CONCEPT TO YOUR STUDENTS. AND THIS isn't a bad thing. But do your students have a deep understanding of why they needed saving? And what they needed saving from?

Salvation, one of the studies in the **elements** line of Bible study curriculum, will help your students see how God was focused on salvation from the very beginning of His interactions with humankind, how salvation is only found through faith in Christ, and what it means to show the world the richness of a life that has been redeemed.

Salvation Lesson Overviews

Lesson 1: The God Who Saves

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that your students would understand how truly remarkable it is that God offers salvation to humankind, and that they would have the chance to express praise and thanks to God for His unfailing desire to offer them life.
- **Scripture Focus:** Genesis 2:15-17, 3:6-7, Romans 5:12, Romans 3:23, Psalm 40:1-3

Lesson 2: Jesus = Salvation

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that your students would understand that only through faith in Christ's work on the cross can they be saved from death, and that they'd be challenged to discover and live out God's purpose for their lives.
- **Scripture Focus:** Matthew 1:18-23, John 14:6, Acts 4:12, Ephesians 2:1-10

Lesson 3: New Life, New Purpose

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that your students would understand that being living examples of the Gospel story—the good news of God's gift of salvation through Christ—is completely intertwined in the new life Jesus made possible for them.
 - **Scripture Focus:** Romans 1:16-17, 2 Corinthians 4:13, Romans 10:9-15, Matthew 5:16, 1 Peter 2:12
