A 3-Lesson Bible Study

Too often our students get the message that their time to make a difference in your church is “out there” somewhere, sometime when they grow up. But, if your teenagers are Believers, then they have been gifted by the Spirit to serve the Church and God’s Kingdom. Today. The time is now!

Spiritual Gifts Lesson Overviews

Lesson 1: The Gift Giver

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would understand that God’s plan to serve His Church is for the Holy Spirit to work in and through Believers, and to begin to consider their attitudes toward the gifts they’ve been given.
- **Scripture Focus:** Exodus 31:1-5, Number 11:16-17, Ezekiel 11:5, Joel 2:28-29, Acts 1:1-8

Lesson 2: Equipped To Serve

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that your students would understand that Jesus paved the way for the Holy Spirit to empower all believers to serve God’s Church and His Kingdom, and to begin to challenge students’ attitudes about their role in serving/growing the Church.
- **Scripture Focus:** Matthew 3:13-4:1, 4:13-15; Luke 4:31-39; John 14:25-26; Acts 2:1-18; Ephesians 4:11-13

Lesson 3: Putting Your Gifts To Good Use

- **Objective:** The point of the lesson is that students would begin to understand exactly what spiritual gifts are and why they’re given, and that they would be challenged to both commit to discovering how the Holy Spirit has gifted them and to using these gifts to serve the Church.
- **Scripture Focus:** 1 Corinthians 12:4-12, Romans 12:3-8, 1 Peter 4:7-11
